### Fee Schedule for Ordinary Members (Effective 1st July 2010)

#### Ordinary Membership Fees

Riders	Quarterly Fee (Baht)

Horse/Pony Boarders	13,500

Membership fees are payable quarterly in advance (calculated based on calendar quarters) and are non refundable, except in the case of transfer from Bangkok or other special circumstances. Members defaulting in payment of quarterly fees shall not be reinstated without payment of unpaid fees.

Lesson fees are payable in advance and have to be used in the quarter. Cancelled lessons can be made up in the following quarter, provided that the membership is still valid. If the rider stops riding, fees for unused lessons are refundable. If cancelled lessons are not used within one month following the quarter, they will be forfeited.
